In addition, variable topic courses such as POLS 291, POLS 306, POLS 485, POLS 489, POLS 491 and POLS 497 may qualify when focused specifically on European politics. Students who would like to inquire or plan for such a course to apply towards the requirements listed should first consult with an Undergraduate Advisor in the Department of Political Science. Other appropriate courses may be approved by the Director of Undergraduate Programs for the Department of Political Science.

This certificate is a means of enhancing undergraduate education through a focused combination of courses and study abroad. Administered by the Political Science Department, the program is open to all Texas A&M University undergraduate students. This certificate is designed to help gain a background for post-graduate studies in European politics or European public policy; as well as a background for a career in the U.S. Foreign Service, international aid work, or for job recruitment in areas such as international business, marketing, or law.

The Certificate in European Union Politics is an initiative of the European Union Center and the Department of Political Science. Both interdisciplinary and international in its orientation, the Certificate program offers students seeking a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree at Texas A&M University the opportunity to combine courses, intermediate level foreign language skills and a study abroad.
